



Bird Feeders

Option 1

What you'll need:

Wild bird seed
Peanut butter
Toilet paper rolls
String or yarn for hanging

Steps:

Spread peanut butter on the outside of the toilet paper roll.
Make sure you cover it well

Pour some bird seed in a shallow dish. Shake gently so it spreads out

Roll the peanut butter covered toilet paper roll in in the seed. Keep rolling and pressing gently until it's well coated

Cut 50cm or so of string. Put it through the hole in the toilet paper roll and knot the ends together

Find a branch, hang your feeder, and wait for the birds to come!



Option 2

What you'll need:

Skinny wood craft sticks
Twine
Hot glue / craft glue
Wild bird seed

Steps:

Glue a row of 10 sticks together to make a base

Glue a stick on 2 sides of the base

Build up your feeder in a log cabin fashion. Add a generous dab of glue to the ends of your sticks and start to stack them

Add your twine for hanging and now all you need to do is add your seed!
